To Whom It May Concern:

Supplier Declaration of Compliance with the European Directive 2002/95/EC dealing with the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (the "RoHS Directive") from the July 1, 2006 the RoHS Directive imposes obligations on the "Producer" of electrical and electronic equipment (i.e. the person who puts a finished product onto the EU market). By making the product available for purchase, the Producer is deemed to be confirming that the product does not contain those substances set out below in amounts that are higher than the currently proposed limits, except where the Annex of the RoHS Directive (attached as Schedule 1) exempts or allows a higher concentration of these restricted substances in designated applications.

Substance	Proposed Limit (by weight in homogenous material)
Lead	0.10%
Mercury	0.10%
Cadmium	0.01%
Hexavalent Chromium	0.10%
Polybrominated biphenyls	0.10%
Polybrominated diphenyl ethers	0.10%

Under the Annex to the RoHS Directive all materials, components or equipment that Bayou Steel Corporation produces do not exceed the tolerated concentration limits of hazardous substances subject to the RoHS Directive.

Exemption: Lead as an alloying element in steel containing up to 0.35% lead by weight, aluminum containing up to 0.4% lead by weight and as a copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight.
